Self- Assessment Examinations (SAE) – Now Available For The Certification for Transplant Preservationist (CTP) Examination

OVERLAND PARK, Kan. (February 2019) - The American Board for Transplant Certification has developed a self-assessment examination (SAE) that can help candidates prepare for the CTP examination! The SAE is 30 questions – the questions created represent an evenly distributed bank of questions from each major category. In addition, questions are created with the same distribution at each cognitive level (recall, application or analysis) to provide the candidate with a realistic examination experience.

The SAE is designed to be an assessment tool to provide you with areas of strengths and weaknesses and not a study guide or a sole source of study.

Individuals who purchase the SAE will receive a link to the web-based product in their email. Once you click on the link and access the SAE, you have 60 days to take the exam. You may exit and enter the exam as many times as you need as long as you do not click on Finish and Grade –at that point access to the SAE will terminate.
